Why Traditional Solutions and Approaches Can't Solve Today's Information Management Challenges



38% Cite that, on average, they have must search three or more systems or locations to find the most current version of a document or file.

44% said that not being able to find a document or file they're looking for happens to them on a weekly basis.



"VERSION CREEP" THE INEVITABLE BY-PRODUCT OF INFORMATION SILOS

4 out of 10 people (41%) say it's difficult to confirm whether they're accessing the most recent version of a file or document.



Nearly half (48%) said they regularly find it difficult to locate the correct document or information because there are multiple systems and storage locations in use at their company.




HOW ARE INFOMATION SILOS IMPACTING BUSINESSES?






2 out of 3

(67%) cite that navigating through different systems and locations to find and verify the most current versions of documents or files NEGATIVELY affects their productivity.




Four out of 10 (40%) use their personal solutions such as Dropbox or Box to share and collaborate on work files because they are easier to use than your company's solutions. Has anyone in your organization used an outdated or inaccurate document that resulted in a negative outcome for the business (i.e. lost deal, contract breaches/problems, customer satisfaction issues, etc.)?



ELIMINATING INFORMATION SILOS -ONCE AND FOR ALL

85% said it would it make their job easier if they could quickly find and access the most current version of a document without having to worry about which system or repository it resides in.
